Who Must Complete It?

- ✓ Travellers entering or leaving South Africa
- ✓ South African citizens
- ✓ Permanent residents
- ✓ Foreign visitors
- ✓ A declaration is required for each traveller, including children and infants

When Must It Be Completed?

24
HOURS

Arriving in South Africa: within 24 hours before your last flight directly to South Africa.

Departing South Africa: within 24 hours before your international departure.

Save or print your confirmation email and keep it available for Customs.

- Failure to complete the declaration may result in penalties.
- Delays at Customs may occur.
- Additional inspections may be conducted.
- Possible enforcement action.
